Raid the Reader texts are completed twice a week in school and focus on the following:

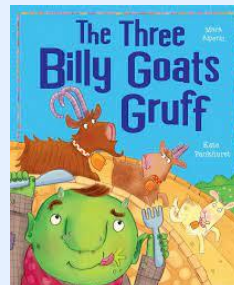

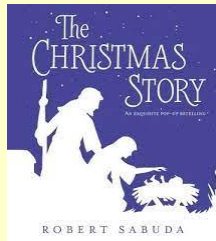
