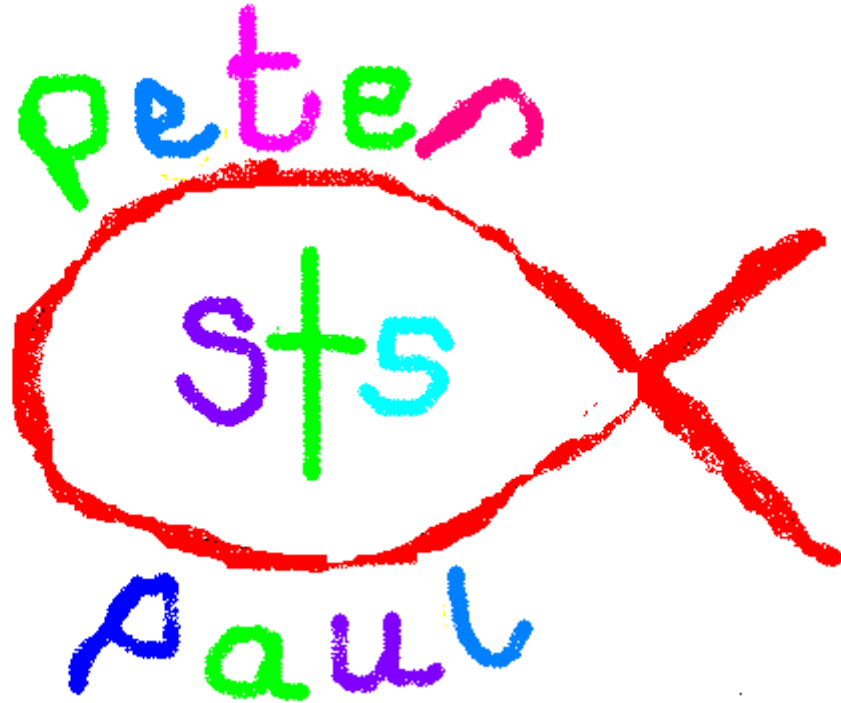

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DIRECTORS & GOVERNORS STATEMENT OF SEND

The Special Educational Needs and Disability Act 2005 and the Equality Act 2010 provides the legal framework for our support of all pupils with SEND. All pupils are treated as individuals with their own specific needs. The resources of our school are targeted so that each pupil can develop their talents to the full. The governors and staff of our school acknowledge their responsibility for making appropriate provision for pupils with SEND. It is the intention that pupils with SEND have equality of opportunity in terms of teacher time and material resources.

All pupils including those with SEND will have access to the National Curriculum as well as the broader balanced school curriculum.

Our school has an obligation to be sensitive to pupils with SEND. These needs are addressed through the provision of a caring and supportive learning environment in which pupils with SEND are able and are encouraged to achieve success.

It is our belief and indeed our practice that all pupils' needs are identified as soon as possible so that early intervention strategies can be deployed. In this way we aim to ensure that the needs of all pupils are met at an early stage so that they may be provided with the necessary support required.

We firmly believe in inclusion and as such the majority of pupils needs are met within the classroom.
